ENGLISH

This term we will be reading the books The Hodgeheg and Paper Bag Princess. We will use these books as part of Guided Reading and English lessons. Alongside our class books we will be continuing with our SPAG lessons.

When reading with your child you could discuss any areas which you and your child particularly enjoyed within a book. Some questions you could ask: what are the characters thinking/feeling? How do you know?

Books will be changed regularly and the phonics book will be changed weekly on a Tuesday.






We will also practise blending sounds together to read words and segmenting sounds to e spell words. Pupils will bring home a z phonics reading book for the week which will match their phonics ability. × Year 2 pupils should be reading for at d least 15 minutes every day. When ar reading with your child, encourage them to sound out tricky words using their phonics and discuss any unfamiliar vocabulary with them. ear b ch ck air !!
