You can do this be asking questions like: what are the characters thinking/feeling? How do they know? Look at the layout of each page and how photos/diagrams in the text are used and ask your child questions about these aspects. Ask your child to really explain their answers using a 'because', if necessary.

Throughout Year 3, the children will be working on groups of objectives linked to the following strands:


- Number and Place Value


PE-Tennis
