### Writing:



#### Reading

As we start the term we will continue our work the properties of shape. So far, we have learnt how to use a protractor to measure and draw accurate angles, as well recap knowledge from Year 4 about the properties of regular and irregular polygons.

This term we will be looking at position and direction. Translating and reflecting shapes with co-ordinates.

As always, our timetables as really important especially as we rely on them to compare fractions and add/subtract when we need to convert our denominators. We will recap learning from one of our previous topics about conductors and insulators as well as look as irreversible changes and how new substances are formed.
