This term, we will be using the Julia Donaldson text, 'Dinosaur Diary', to inspire us to write our own diary entries. We will be continuing to think about sentence structure, but will also be learning about descriptive language, question marks and exclamation marks.

In the second half of the term, we will look at non-fiction texts about dinosaurs. We will use our knowledge to create our own fact files about dinosaurs.

Mathematics

This half term, we will be learning about addition and subtraction.

We will be using a variety of strategies to add and subtract numbers within 10, such as part whole models, bar models and writing number sentences. We will use lots of practical resources to help us with our learning.

Towards the end of term, we will learn about 2D and 3D shapes. We will be making sure we can name the shapes and will begin to talk about their properties.

SCENCE

This term in Science our topic is 'Materials'.

We will be looking at the different types of materials we have, naming the material an object is made from and beginning to think about the properties of a material.

We will use our knowledge to carry out simple investigations, to find out which material would be most suitable for a purpose.



Phonics!

In phonics, children will continue to be grouped across EYFS and KS1, according to their current phonics knowledge. They will receive two phonics sessions daily. The first will be a speed sound session, where we will learn and recap specific sounds and words. The second session is a storybook session, where children apply their phonics knowledge to read books that are phonetically matched to their level.



History – In History this term, we will be learning about life in the 1950s. We will look at what day to day life, childhood and schooling was like in the 1950s and will discuss the similarities and differences to life in the present day. We will also learn about the coronation of Queen Elizabeth.


PE – In PE this term, our topic is dance. We will be learning and performing a simple dance routine to a song from The Lion King.

DT – In DT this term, we will be using sewing techniques to design and make our own glove puppets.
