
Year 6 Newsletter

This term in Science our topic is 'Electricity

In this topic we build on our knowledge of electricity from Year 4. We will begin by making and drawing simple circuits as well as learning the symbols for the different components that can be included in a circuit and their role.

Later in the term we will learn about what happens when there is a fault in a circuit, we will investigate the effects of increasing the voltage and how we can limit the flow of electricity in a circuit.
