Pupil Premium information

Pupil Premium Pupil Premium is a sum of money paid to school that is used to



enhance your child's learning. This funding subsidises costs towards things such as school trips (making them cheaper for you!), visitors to school, events and equipment for learning.

Here is a useful website that tells you what Pupil Premium is and how it can be spent. It also lists the eligibility criteria <u>https://</u> <u>www.theschoolrun.com/parents-guide-pupilpremium</u>.

All children who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) are also entitled automatically to Pupil Premium.

We would like to encourage you to try and apply for FSM if you think that you are eligible, even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, as this could mean that we can help support you even more with the costs of things like trips and clubs.

You can apply via the Calderdale Council website using the following link <u>https://</u> <u>calderdalecouncil.custhelp.com/ app/free-</u> <u>school-meals</u>. The form only requires your details and your child's details.

It is very straightforward, however if you require assistance then please ask at the school office.
