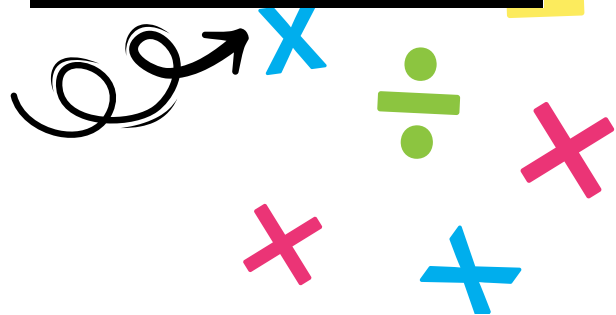

English

This term, our first book will be 'The Many Worlds of Albie Bright' by Christopher Edge. We will be creating our own likeable characters and writing our own science fiction stories. This term, we will be learning how to use parenthesis in a description.

Maths

This term, we will begin by looking at place value. We will be learning how to represent, partition, compare and order numbers up to 1,000,000. We will then look at the addition and subtraction. We will be learning about how to add and subtract numbers up to 6-digits.

Science

This term, our science topic is 'Forces'. As part of this unit, we will be planning, investigating and recording results to experiments. We will start by exploring air resistance, friction and gravity, before moving onto water resistance.
