All you need to do is wear odd socks! Odd Socks Day is a great way to celebrate what makes us all unique and special.

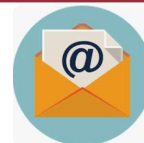
Odd Socks Day 2023 will take place on Monday 13th November, marking the start of Anti-Bullying Week!
