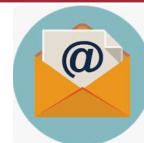

Year 1/2 Forest School

Wildlife Detecting

We decided to focus on birdlife for this session.

We went outside and tried to spot as many different birds as we could by sight. Then we used the Merlin app to identify the birds by their call and songs. We learnt the call of the woodpigeon and magpie. These are the birds we saw and/or heard:

- Sparrow (lots of them twittering away in the hedgerows)
- Carrion crow
- Black-head gull (flying overhead)
- Woodpigeon (large plump grey birds sitting in the trees and calling to one another)
- Blackbird (eating hawthorn berries)
- Robin (we only heard their song, but there was lots of it!)
- Magpie
- Dunnock (mainly in hedgerows)

We had a great day raising money for Children in Need on Thursday!

The theme was **spotacular** and everybody looked fantastic in their bright colours and spots!
