Enhanced Reward System—Y1-6

How exciting! We are starting to see a number of children begin to receive the bronze badges and medals this term so we thought that we'd remind you about the enhanced reward system that we have in school.

We love to reward pupils for their efforts and, last year, we multiplied the number of Achievement Points (APs) that children can receive each week. On top of the usual ways to earn APs, pupils can also earn enhanced points for things like demonstrating good oracy skills, representing the academy at internal and external events (e.g. class assemblies, school trips etc) and much more!

The number of points possible for these activities can range from 10 – 20 APs at a time! **Wow!**

Children earn badges and medals for the following points:

Bronze 250+

Silver 500+

Gold 750+
